

Services offered on Nationwide Children's Hospital's Mobile Care Units:

- Yearly check-up or physical (reviewing growth and development)
 - Forms (child medical statements for daycare, early head start, school and recreational sports, work permits, etc.)
 - If your child (*3 years and older*) has had a check-up or physical in the past *one* (1) year at Nationwide Children's Hospital, their form can be completed based on that check-up (you may receive a call from the provider if there are any questions or concerns)
- Immunizations
 - Covered for anyone *18 years and younger* regardless of insurance through the federally funded Vaccines for Children (VFC) program
- Blood work
 - If indicated at yearly check-up or physical
 - Can also complete orders placed by other providers or specialists at Nationwide Children's Hospital
- Same-day sick visits (fever, sore throat, cough, headache, ear pain, lice, etc.)
- Medication follow-up and refills
- Diagnosis and management of chronic health conditions (asthma, allergies, acne, headaches, weight management, etc.)
- Adolescent health
 - Menstrual disorders
 - Screening and educating about high-risk behaviors
 - Reproductive health counseling and education for girls *and* boys
 - Contraceptive services
 - Testing and treatment of sexually transmitted infections
- Behavioral and mental health services (screening and treating depression, anxiety, ADHD, etc.)
 - Remote telehealth consultations (if needed)
- Care Connection
 - Link patients and families to a primary care provider or medical home at Nationwide Children's Hospital
- Referrals
 - Specialists
 - School based programs (asthma therapy, diabetes management, dental care)
 - Care navigation (helping families navigate the health care system and removing barriers)
 - Community resources (food, housing, transportation, utilities, early intervention programs, etc.)
 - Legal help (family issues, debt, education, guardianship, benefits, housing, etc.)
 - Financial support based on eligibility criteria (*no child should be refused care due to inability to pay*)
 - Help families sign up for insurance or find out if families qualify for financial assistance
