Bipartisan Support for Policies that Aid Family Caregivers

The John A. Hartford Foundation asked adults living in the U.S. for their opinions on policies to help family caregivers. Agreement is near-universal:

Action is needed to support family caregivers.

94% support providing free training for family caregivers who need to perform medical tasks.

95% Democrats

93% Independents

93% support bringing in professional direct care workers so that family caregivers can rest.
